Exhibition: December 1, 2012-March 31, 2013



Otto Frank's numerous photographs of his family
were dutifully mounted in albums and captioned
by his wife, Edith, and later Anne Frank wrote
captions as well. That was long before the family
sought refuge in the secret annex above Otto
Frank's office in Amsterdam in 1942.

The exhibition includes 71 of Otto Frank's 400 photographs that
originally filled four albums hidden in the Annex. After the family was
discovered and deported the albums remained hidden in the Annex
along with Anne's diary until Otto Frank returned in 1945. He was
the only member of his family to return.

A 28-minute award-winning documentary film, "*The Short Life of
Anne Frank*," accompanies the exhibit and can be viewed in the
DHM/CET's theater.
