

FAQ ABOUT HOPE FOR HUMANITY

Q: When and where is the event this year?

A: The event will be on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 and is hosted at the Fairmont Dallas, located at 1717 N Akard Street adjacent to the beautiful Dallas Arts District. Complimentary cocktails begin at 6:00 p.m. There are no hors d'oeuvres during this reception, but we will have a sumptuous 3-course seated dinner beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the ballroom.

Q: It is a weeknight. How long will the event last?

A: We open dinner seating as early as 6:30 p.m. so we can promptly do our Welcome Remarks inside the ballroom at 7:00 p.m. We aim to start the featured program at 8:00 p.m., which includes a moving tribute to our local Holocaust survivors, an update on the state of the Museum and a featured recognition of our Hope for Humanity Honoree. Our goal is to finish promptly between 8:45-9:00 p.m.

Q: What are the parking accommodations?

A: The Museum hosts complimentary valet parking at the Fairmont Dallas (self-parking is not available at the venue). Because Hope for Humanity welcomes upward of 1,000 attendees, the valet line can take up to 15 minutes during heavy arrival. As such, we recommend arriving early (enjoy a drink at the bar!), carpooling to the event with friends or considering an on-demand private driving service.

Q: What is the attire?

A: We recommend business attire for the event.

Q: I see that tables of 10 start at \$5,500 each. Is there an option to attend by purchasing single tickets?

A: Early table sales take up the majority of our table inventory. As such, we delay offering a \$550 single ticket option until closer to the date, based on availability. Email Events@DallasHolocaustMuseum.org if you wish to be included in a mail list for single tickets, which will be after August 31, 2017.

Q: I purchased a table of 10. How will my guests know what our assigned table is?

A: If you have not done so already, email the names of your guests to Events@DallasHolocaustMuseum.org. Upon arrival to the Fairmont Dallas that evening, have your guests check-in at our registration tables. We will distribute seating cards for your hosted table. If we do not receive the names of your guests, they can also check-in under your last name as the designated table host.

Q: What if I purchased a table of 10, but decide to give it back because I am seated with friends at another table or am no longer able to attend?

A: All table and single ticket sales are final. Email Events@DallasHolocaustMuseum.org immediately so we can release your table and reassign your seating. If you notify us before October 1, 2017, we will change your fair market value to reflect zero benefits received and a 100% tax-deductible contribution. Notification after October 1 will maintain a \$750 fair market value for any table of 10.
